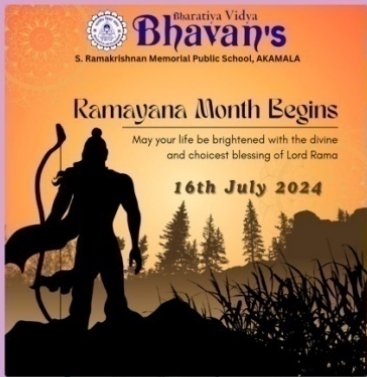
The mass Ramayana Parayanam (reading/recitation) by students of Classes VII to XI was a highlight of the event, showcasing their dedication and enthusiasm.

The description of Dasapushpam by students of Class VII added a unique touch to the event.

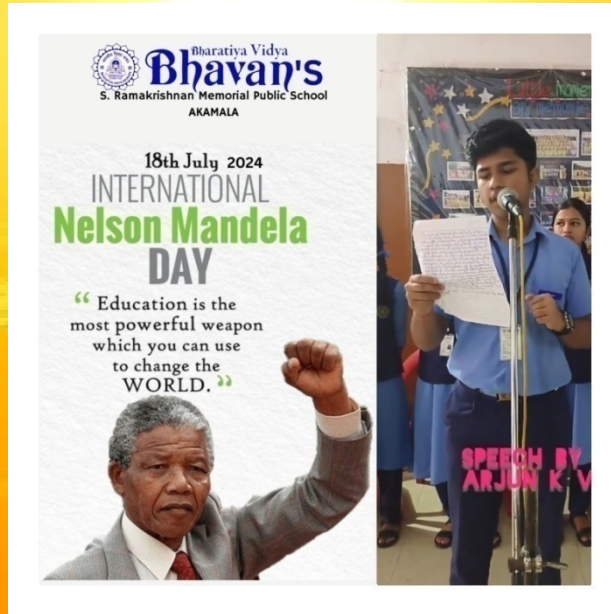

TEACHER 'S TALK

There was once an old locksmith's shop in the middle of the city. People used to buy locks and keys from there. Sometimes, even to get duplicate keys if they lost the original. The shop also had a heavy hammer, which was occasionally used to break the locks. The hammer would often wonder, what is the quality in these small keys that can open such strong locks in a pinch, whereas I have to strike so many times for the same?

One day he could not stand it, and after the shop was closed he asked a little key, "Sister, tell me, what is this power in you that you can open such stubborn locks so easily, while I can't do it even though I'm so strong?" The key smiled and said, "Actually, you exert force to open the locks and hit them, breaking them in the process. I never hurt a lock, I just touch his heart by making my place there. After that, as soon as I request him to open, he opens immediately. "

It may be possible to force someone to do some work. But that way, we do not open the lock. Instead, we break it. That is, we destroy the usefulness and the innate talent of that person. HARDWORK AND PATIENCE

In ancient times in India, children were sent to Gurukul to study. Students used to stay and study in the gurukul and do duties like cleaning the gurukul, watering the plants and cooking food etc. just like that, there was a gurukul near the forest far away from the town where hundreds of children used to get education under the guidance of their master. Once, a boy was also sent to gurukul to study. Soon he got friendly with other students in gurukul but he was very weak in studies. He would do daily duties diligently, but anything that the master taught him was poorly understood by him, and for this reason, he was often ridiculed by other students.

At year end, all his classmates were promoted to the next class, but he couldn't make it. Master tried to teach him by every possible method, but the boy would not understand. Finally, the master gave up and said to the boy 'son I have tried everything and made all efforts to help you learn, but still you can't understand anything'. Perhaps education is not in your destiny. So, it's better that you go home and help your family with their household work. The boy also thought that perhaps studies are not something that he can do, and with a heavy heart, he left to his home. The boy was walking towards his home, which was about 20 miles from the gurukul. While walking he started feeling thirsty, so he went around looking for water. Looking around, he found some women filling water from a well. He went near the well to drink water, when he got near the well, he saw some marks on solid stone kept near the well which was used rope to draw water from the well. He asked the woman how did you make these marks on the stone. The woman replies that we didn't make this mark. It is there because of this soft rope, which is repeatedly used over it while drawing water from a well. Repeated use of rope made such marks on this stone. Listening to this, the boy kept on thinking that if repeated movement of soft rope can make deep marks on such a solid rock, then why can't he learn from constant practice. Inspired by this incident, he went back to gurukul with a lot of enthusiasm and started studying tirelessly. Master was also happy seeing him working hard and cooperating fully with him. After a few years, this boy became renowned by the name of Acharya Varadraj, who was a great scholar of Sanskrit grammar. Even after hundreds of years, these grammar books have remained unmatched. We must bring two qualities in our life: strong determination and tireless practice if we need to succeed in life.
