Academic Excellence

The system of education in , Bharatiya Vidya Bhavans S Ramakrishnan Memorial Public School, Akamala as you all know, is a blend of theory and practice in the right proportion to arrive at a comprehensive curriculum. Results of AISSE and AISSCE 2020 are a proven specimen for this. Our students have shown an excellent performance and secured centum results in X and XII board exams 2023.

Out of 12 students six of them secured above 90 % marks in Commerce Stream. Ardra K Baburaj with 98% was the school topper in AISSCE Result. Pavithra S Krishna secured 96.2% and became the second topper of the school and Uthara K J took the third position with 93.6%.

School rendered a helping hand to the poor and the needy. The students of classes 8 & 9 made a visit to "Snehalayam," an old age home located at Mundathikode. They provided the inmates with the things for their basic necessity and also sponsored the lunch with their poor fund collection. ART INTEGRATED EXHIBITION :- ARTFUL WHIMSY

On 26th January 2024, an art integrated exhibition related to Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat was organized in the school. Students from KG to class XII participated in the programme. Various activities done by students related to art integration with paired state on different subjects were displayed. In the auditorium, folk art of paired state, Chhattisgarh was performed by the students. Class 7 and class 8 performed the folk songs of Chhattisgarh, and class 6 performed the folk dance.

NEW INITIATIVE

All the infrastructure facilities of the school have been expanded including the construction of the well facilitated Chemistry, Biology, Physics and Computer Labs which is required to commence Science stream in the next academic year. The school obtained the approval from CBSE in the month of January to begin the Science Stream in Senior Secondary Level from the Academic year 2024-2025 onwards.

Career Guidance and Counselling :

On 24th June, school organized a training for parents on 'Effective Parenting' with the support of Ratna Sagar publications. The chief guest and trainer was Mr. Vijayakumar.R . Parents of Pre kg to class II attended the training.
