BAKRID CELEBRATION 2025




5TH JUNE 2025


After the stage programme, students along with the chief guest and the other dignitaries planted tree saplings in the school premises.

In connection with the International Day Against Drug Abuse observed on June 26, 2025, a drawing competition






Subject: Celebration of International Day of Yoga (IDY) 2025


