23RD AUGUST 2025


SPACE DAY CELEBRATION

The students thoroughly enjoyed the puppet show, understood the morals of the stories, and expressed eagerness to watch more such performances in the future.




30TH AUGUST 2025




PRIMARY CLASS ACTIVITIES




6TH JULY 2025
