## **HUMAN RIGHTS DAY**



National Energy Conservation Day was observed on 14<sup>th</sup> December. An awareness video on energy conservation was shown to the students, and a quiz based on the video was conducted.





## BIRTHDAY OF K. M. MUNSHI




