The beggar gently replied,

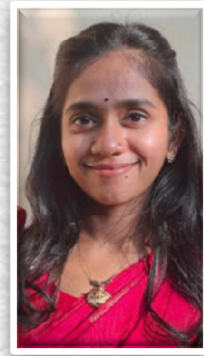

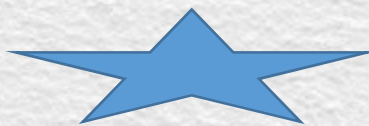

Subject: CBSE Budding Authors Programme 2025-26

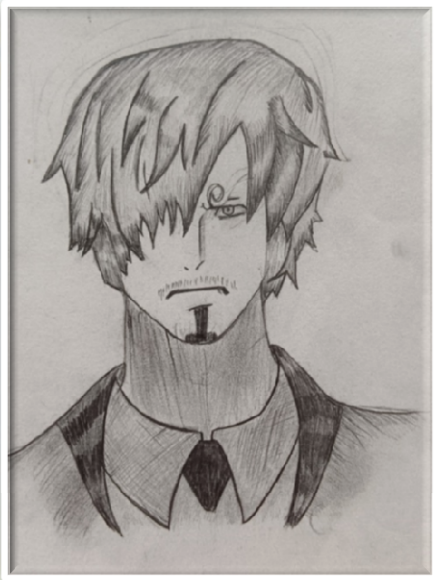
