Academic Excellence

The academic year 2024–25 witnessed outstanding performances by students of Classes X and XII in the SSE and SSCE board examinations. The results reflect the school’s commitment to excellence and the dedicated efforts of students, teachers and parents. Numerous students scored above 95 in multiple subjects, while perfect scores (100/100) were recorded in Sanskrit, Artificial Intelligence, and Accountancy.

A. S. Krishnagayathri emerged as the school topper in the SSCE Class XII Results 2025, securing an outstanding 96.4% with A1 grades in all subjects. Vaiga Sajeev emerged as a Class X school topper, securing an impressive 97.8%. Aarya P secured the second position with 97.6%, followed by Aardra M in third place with 96.8%. All three secured full A1 in all subjects.

The month of June 2025 was marked by a series of vibrant celebrations and observances at our school. World Environment Day and Bakrid were celebrated on 5th June with cultural programmes in the school auditorium. Chief guest of the day was Ummer master, retired teacher and member of SCERT book development Committee.

Reading Week was inaugurated on 19th June with enthusiastic participation, and the event was graced by Mr. Jayaraj Mitra, a renowned writer and recipient of national and state awards. As part of the Reading Week celebrations, students visited the public library on 24th June. Subsequently, a Book Exhibition was organized at the

school on 25th June. On 21st June, the school celebrated International Yoga Day and World Music Day with great passion, highlighting the importance of health and creativity.

A solemn homage was paid to our beloved First chairman and patron of Wadakkanchery kendra, Shri G. Sivaswami, on 30th June 2025, honouring his visionary leadership, enduring values, and dedicated service to education with pride and gratitude.

The Space Expo 2025, organized by Vivruti on 7th October 2025 at our school, featured inspiring sessions by eminent scientists, interactive discussions on space technology, and a thrilling rocket launch that ignited curiosity and scientific enthusiasm among students.

A Health and Hygiene talk was conducted on 16th July, and the Bhavan's Balamandir Ramayana Fest was celebrated with enthusiasm, along with the Colours Day observance featuring the primary colour red on 29th July.
